THE RONALD L. BAKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Ronald (“Ron”) Lawrence Baker graduated Drexel University in 1980 with a chemical engineering degree. He was later employed as a chemical engineer at EcoChem Analytics. Ron was a loving father, devoted husband, family member and dedicated friend to Polonia. He was proud of his Polish heritage and volunteered as the longest running President of the Westchester Pulaski Association, Inc. from 1998 to 2015. The Ronald L. Baker Memorial Scholarship has been created in honor of our former President, an individual who was committed to engineering and also heavily involved in the Polish American community in Westchester County.

This scholarship is available to college students of Polish ancestry majoring in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (“STEM”) related field.

Eligibility for the scholarship award is based upon the following qualifications:

- 1) The applicant must be of Polish descent (i.e. one or more parents or grandparents).
- 2) The applicant must be a resident of Westchester County (parents must reside in Westchester County if applicant is attending an undergraduate program outside of the county or state).
- 3) The applicant must be matriculated in an undergraduate program leading to a degree in STEM. High school seniors will not be considered for the scholarship. Freshman enrolled in an undergraduate degree will be considered, however priority will be given to student farther along in their STEM education.
- 4) The applicant must have earned a cumulative grade point average (“GPA”) of 2.5 or higher each term after the first semester.
- 5) Financial need of the applicant will be taken into consideration.
- 6) All applications must be fully completed and postmarked or received by the Scholarship Committee no later than February 9, 2026. All applications become the property of the Westchester Pulaski Association Inc.

These one year awards will be distributed to the recipients as follows:

- 1) A single payment will be made. This is a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$750.
- 2) The award will be paid directly to the recipient.
- 3) All decisions of this Association's Scholarship Committee are final.
- 4) The Scholarship Committee will not award scholarships to applicants who are not qualified and reserves the right to not award a scholarship in a given year.
- 5) Notification to the recipients will be made approximately two weeks prior to the Annual Scholarship Luncheon held on March 22, 2026 in Yonkers, New York.
- 6) To maximize the impact of this funding, students receiving full scholarships from other sources are not eligible.
